RULES

The organising authority of the regatta is the
 Mosquito Catamaran Association of South Australia/ Adelaide Sailing Club
 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing .
 The class rules of the **Mosquito** Class shall apply.

ADVERTISING

Advertising will be as defined by ISAF regulation 20.
 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
 The organising authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the South Australian or Australian Governments.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the **Mosquito** class.
 Competitors must be aged 12 years old [minimum] or have completed the Basic Proficiency Course. Proof of age may be required.
 Competitors must be current members of their State Mosquito Association
 Please note the Entry Fee is **\$100** inclusive for the three days of racing. For partial participation nomination fees will be \$40/day. There can be up to 3 races sailed each day, details in the NoR Schedule below and the SI. Please submit fees via EFT, see link to nomination form below.
 The AGM will be conducted Saturday evening at the conclusion of Saturday's evening meal, also at ASC, to which you are all invited. The AGM agenda link will be here and on the MCASA website [here](#).

PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- When fewer than **5** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- When **5** to **7** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- When **8** to **9** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

SAFETY

All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices which are in good condition and are in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation and branded in the country of origin or manufacture.

Attention is drawn to Rule 1.2 and Rule 4

Discretionary penalties will apply to Rule 41 – Outside Help. Actions of the Race Committee in retrieving crews from the water and returning them to their boats may not be penalised.

SUPPORT BOATS

Team managers, coaches and other support personnel shall register by completing a registration form available at registration. Approved Support Boats shall keep at least 100m clear of the course area during racing, except when asked to assist by the race committee.

RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the organising authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.



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RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, a boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio transmissions except for equipment provided by the organising authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

MkI State Champion, 2nd and 3rd placings

MkII State Champion, 2nd and 3rd placings

Handicap: fleet calculation

Timber boat: Best performing timber boat on handicap

Additional prizes for heavyweight boats, female competitor, veteran and junior skippers may be awarded.

Other prizes may be awarded by MCASA and the Organising Authority, Adelaide Sailing Club

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race, link [here](#).

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10M Aus.

All owners/competitors who sign the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.
