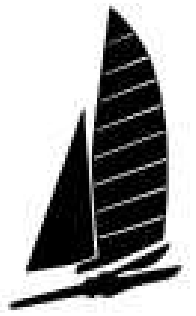


NOTICE OF RACE



**2014 Victorian Mosquito MkI State Championships
In Conjunction with the
Victorian Arrow Class State Championships
To be held at Portarlington SC
8-10 March 2014**



The organising authority is Portarlington Sailing Club Inc. and the Victorian Mosquito Catamaran Association Inc. The regatta will be conducted at the Portarlington Sailing Club.

1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Prescriptions of Yachting Australia.

2 Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all Mosquito MkI class boats that comply with the class Building Rules and Restrictions.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on the VMCA web site and completing registration (including payment of entry fees) at the Portarlington Sailing Club from 8:00am to 10:00am on Saturday 8 March 2014.

Entry is conditional upon the following:

- All skippers must be financial members of a State Mosquito Catamaran Association.
- All boats shall be covered by third party insurance cover of not less than \$10,000,000 for any accident. Insurer and Policy Number is required on the entry form.
- All competitors must be financial members of a Sailing Club currently affiliated with Yachting Australia through the relevant State Authority. Yachting Australia membership number is required on the entry form.
- Any person who fulfils the above conditions shall be eligible to win the regatta but the title of 'Victorian State Champion' will only be awarded to persons who normally sail in Victoria.

4 Schedule

A maximum of 7 races will be conducted with 1 or 2 races in each of the sessions listed below.

1st start times are for the first division.

Classes will start in the following order, Mosquito Mk I then Arrow.

A five minute start sequence will be used.

5 Measurement

All boats shall comply with the Mosquito class Building Rules and Restrictions. Boats shall be made available for measurement checks as requested at any time prior to, during and after the series.

6 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the Portarlington Sailing Club from 9.00am 8 March 2014.

7 Venue

The Club is located on the Bellarine Peninsula, 30 km east of Geelong. Racing will be on the waters of Port Phillip, to the North of the club house.

8 Courses

The style of course to be used will be triangle/windward-return. Details will appear in the Sailing Instructions

9 Penalty System

For the Mosquito class rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

For the Arrow and Arafura classes rule 44.1 is unchanged.

10 Scoring

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.1 Discards

When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for outright placing's, handicap, and special categories at the discretion of the organisers. Perpetual trophies will be provided to the major winners.

12 Disclaimer Of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
