NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority for this Championship is Rye Yacht Club in conjunction with the Victorian Mosquito Catamaran Association (VMCA).

1 RULES

1.1

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, and the class rules of the Mosquito Catamaran.

1.2

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1

The regatta is open to all boats of the Mosquito Catamaran class

2.2

Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on the VMCA web site by 8th March 2018 or register at Rye Yacht Club on the morning of the 10th March 2018

2.3

Entry is conditional upon the following:

- All skippers must be financial members of a State Mosquito Catamaran Association.
- All boats shall be covered by third party insurance cover of not less than \$10,000,000 for any accident. Insurer name and policy number are required on the entry form.
- All competitors must be financial members of a Sailing Club currently affiliated with Australian Sailing through the relevant State Authority. Australian Sailing membership number is required on the entry form.
- Any person who fulfils the above conditions shall be eligible to win the regatta but the title of 'Victorian State Champion' will only be awarded to persons who normally sail in Victoria.

4.3 Racing

A maximum of 7 races will be conducted with a maximum of 3 races in each of the sessions listed below.

1st start times are for the first division.
A three minute start sequence will be used.

No warning signal will be given after 14:00 hrs on the last scheduled day of racing.

4.4 Presentation

Presentation will be held as soon as possible after the last race.

5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall comply with the Mosquito Catamaran class Building Rules and Restrictions. Boats may be checked for compliance at any time during the event at the discretion of the Race Committee.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at Registration.

7 VENUE

Racing will be conducted from Rye Yacht Club.

8 THE COURSES

The courses will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

10.1 Scoring System

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

10.2 Minimum Number of Races

Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 Drops

When from five to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 PRIZES

Prizes to be awarded are; Mkl State Champion, MkII State Champion Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising committee.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
